Have you seen...

people acting suspiciously around your clients, perhaps in a car or van?

Have you heard...

about offers of work that sound too good to be true?

Have you noticed...

people disappearing from your service or the streets?

Is your client...

displaying fear, anxiety, injuries or poor health? Do they appear confused, traumatised or controlled by someone else? Are they without ID or unable to speak English? Are they working to pay off debts or for very low wages?

Traffickers target vulnerable people. Your clients may be at risk.
